<u>PRIZES</u>	Medals will be awarded to the 1 st and 2 nd place U19, U17, U15 & U13 age brackets. Cash prizes will be awarded in the Adult Open Gender Singles & Doubles Categories. If there are enough adult players requesting to be put in a biological female only draw then medals will be awarded to the 1 st & 2 nd place finishers of the Biological female only draw. (Prize money for the Adult Open Gender Categories will be based on 50% of the Adult Open Gender Category registrations. *(Open Gender singles & doubles category is an all genders draw which includes all players regardless of gender.
<u>CONDITIONS OF</u> <u>PARTICIPATION:</u>	The tournament is open to all Players who have active memberships with their provincial badminton associations for the current 2024/25 season.
Events offered:	Singles & Doubles (if two different genders play together as a team, they will be placed in the open gender doubles draw)



<u>SHUTTLES</u> :	Players must provide their own shuttles. Yonex AS20, As30, As40 or As50 Feather Shuttles must be used for the Adult Open, U19 & U17 age players (Tubes of Yonex AS20 Feather shuttles will be available for sale \$40 per tube at the draw desk). Plastic shuttles will be provided for free all the under 15 & 13 age brackets.

<u>TOURNAMENT</u> <u>FORMAT</u> :	Various draw formats will be used to guarantee every player gets a minimum of three matches per event. (Pool Play, Compass draws, ABCD) All Singles Games in all categories will be best of 3 to 15 points (win by 2 points but ending at 21). All Junior doubles is best of 3 to 15pts (win by 2 points but ending at 21) Open doubles will be best of 3 to 21 pts (win by 2 points ending at 30)
