DATE: Saturday, Mar 30, 2024, for Open, U19, U17, U15, U13 (Singles and Doubles) **OPEN PRIZES:** Open gender singles: \$75 for 1st place, \$25 for 2nd place Open gender doubles: \$100 for 1st place, \$50 for 2nd place U19, U17, U15, U13: Medals awarded to first and second place of A section. Prizes **JUNIOR PRIZES:** awarded to winner of B and C sections. No prize for winner of D section. If round robin draw, medals awarded to first and second place. \$25 for one event / \$35 for two events - payable at draw desk upon arrival or ENTRY FEE: e-transfer to Diane MacLeod at sijbc98@gmail.com. **CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:** The tournament is open to all players who have active memberships with Badminton New Brunswick for the current 2023/24 season. **Open** - All ages AGE CATEGORIES: <mark>U19</mark> – players born in 2006, 2007 or later U17 – players born in 2008, 2009 or later **U15** – players born in 2010, 2011 or later U13 – players born in 2012, 2013 or later **ENTRY DEADLINE:** Thursday, Mar 28, 2024, at 9 pm HOW TO REGISTER: Email Diane MacLeod at sjjbc98@gmail.com with the following details 1. Full name 2. Birth year 3. Gender, male or female 4. Events being played - singles, doubles, or both 5. If playing doubles, indicate partner's name or requesting a partner 6. Age category for singles and doubles One day tournament, limited to 75 players' total. Acceptance is on a first REGISTRATION registered basis. Players may only sign up for one single and/or one double category. Saint John Junior Badminton Club (SJJBC) and Kennebecasis Valley Badminton **ORGANIZERS:** Club (KVBC)

<u>VENUE</u> :	Millidgeville North School, 500 Woodward Avenue, Saint John, E2K 4G7, use gym entrance marked by the sign "Anglophone South School District."
<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u>	At regional tournaments we allow females to be placed in draws with males if requested and as well if there are not enough female participants to make a female only draw. If a particular age category does not have enough players then they will be merged with the age category above them. Our focus is game experience and fun rather than separating genders and ages that do not have enough players to make at least a round robin draw of four.
<u>FORMAT</u> :	A, B, C, D draws. If not enough for this type of draw, then round robin will be played. We will do our best to guarantee three matches in each event. Depending on number of participants in U15, U17 and U19 only (not Open), games may be modified to 15 points in a best of 3-game match for singles only (not doubles).
<u>SHUTTLES</u> :	<u>Open:</u> Feather shuttles must be used <u>U19 and U17</u> : Yonex Mavis 300 plastic shuttles (provided) will be used due to upcoming high school tournaments being played with plastic. Feather shuttles can be used if agreed to by both players. <u>U15 and U13</u> : Yonex Mavis 300 plastic shuttles provided.
	Feather shuttles will be available for sale from the draw desk for a cost of \$30 per tube (Li Ning G600). SJJBC and KVBC will supply feather shuttles to their club members at no cost.
EYEWEAR:	The use of safety eyewear is recommended.
<u>SCHEDULE</u> :	<u>U15, U13</u> : Doors open at 830 am, singles match start at 9 am followed by doubles (at approximately 1130 am) – Downstairs gym <u>U19, U17</u> : Doors open at 830, singles matches start at 9 am followed by doubles (at approximately 12 noon) – Upstairs gym <u>Open</u> : Singles matches start at 2 pm followed by doubles (at approximately 4 pm) – Upstairs gym (warmup in downstairs gym)

Depending on number of registrations in each category, the times may be modified. If this happens, an email will go out to all participants after registration closes (Mar 28th at 9 pm) informing them of the time changes.
