FORMAT: Various draw formats will be used to guarantee every player gets a

minimum of three matches per event. (Pool Play, Compass draws, ABCD) All Singles Games in all categories will be best of 3 to 15 points (win by 2

points but ending at 21).

All Junior doubles is best of 3 to 15pts (win by 2 points but ending at 21) Open doubles will be best of 3 to 21 pts (win by 2 points ending at 30)
