



## Moncton Golden Goose Regional Series

**DATE OF EVENT:** Saturday, October 14th, 2023

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Thursday, October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2023

**PRIZES** Medals will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place U19, U17, U15 & U13 age brackets. Cash prizes will be awarded in the Open Gender Singles & Doubles Categories. Prize money will be based on 50% of the Open Gender Category registrations. The Open Gender singles & doubles category is an all genders draw which includes all players regardless of gender. If there are enough biological females in the open registrations that request a biological female only category then we will make a separate draw for them and medals will be awarded for the first and second place finishers.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$30- payable at draw desk upon arrival

**HOW TO REGISTER:** Email us your registration at [mbc.inc@rogers.com](mailto:mbc.inc@rogers.com) and you will receive a confirmation email within 2 days. Please include the following details:

- full name
- Gender Identity - Male, female or other (please specify)
- Draw preference- Open Gender or Biological Female only
- Birth year – only the year is required – (do not include the day or month)
- Choose a specific age bracket - U13, U15, U17, U19 or Open (adult)  
(See specific birth years below and choose a bracket you are eligible to play)
- List What Events you are playing- Singles Only? Doubles Only? Or Both.
- If playing doubles - indicate Partners Name...or requesting Partner.

**Age Categories:**

- Open – players born in 2005 or older.**
- U19 – birth year (2006 & 2007) or younger**
- U17 – birth year (2008 & 2009) or younger**
- U15 – birth year (2010 & 2011) or younger**
- U13 - birth year (2012 & 2013) or younger**

**CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:** The tournament is open to all Players who have active memberships with their provincial badminton associations for the current 2023/24 season.

**Events offered:** Singles & Doubles (if two different genders play together as a team, they will be placed in the open gender doubles draw)

**SHUTTLES:** Players must provide their own shuttles. Yonex AS20, As30, As40 or As50 **Feather Shuttles** must be used for the Open, U19 & U17 age players (Tubes of Yonex AS20 Feather shuttles will be available for sale \$35 per tube at the draw desk). Plastic shuttles will be provided for all the under 15 & 13 age brackets.

- EYEWEAR:** The use of safety eyewear is strongly recommended.
- TOURNAMENT  
FORMAT:** Various draw formats will be used to guarantee every player gets a minimum of three matches per event. (Pool Play, Compass draws, ABCD)  
All Singles Games in all categories will be best of 3 to 15 points (win by 2 points but ending at 21).  
All Junior doubles is best of 3 to 15pts (win by 2 points but ending at 21)  
Open doubles will be best of 3 to 21 pts (win by 2 points ending at 30)
