DATE OF EVENT: Saturday, September 9th, 2023

ENTRY DEADLINE: Thursday, September 7th -2023

PRIZES Medals will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place U19, U17, U15 & U13 age brackets. Cash prizes will be awarded in the Open Singles & Doubles Categories. Prize money will be based on 50% of the Open aged Category registrations. The Open aged singles & doubles category will consist of an all genders draw to include all players regardless of gender unless there are enough players registered to create a separate second draw to include both all gender & female only categories.

ENTRY FEE: \$30- payable at draw desk upon arrival

HOW TO REGISTER: Email us your registration at mbc.inc@rogers.com and you will receive a confirmation email within 2 days. Please include the following details:

- full name
- Gender Identity - Male, female or other (please specify)
- Draw preference- Open Gender or Female
- Birth year – only the year is required
- choose a specific age bracket - U13, U15, U17, U19 or Open (adult)

(See specific birth years below and choose a bracket you are eligible to play)

- List What Events you are playing- Singles Only? Doubles Only? Or Both.
- If playing doubles - indicate Partners Name...or requesting Partner.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION: The tournament is open to all Players who have active memberships with their provincial badminton associations for the current 2022/23 season. BNNB Memberships are validated through our BNNB Validation membership link which is free to sign up as long as you are a current member of BNNB. Below is the BNNB Validation link but please understand this is not the tournament registration but simply a visual list of all BNNB members. This is a tool for regional tournament hosts to validate you are a member of BNNB.

Validation Link: Will be added soon – Link has not been made yet for this season

Age Categories:

- Open – players born in 2005 or before.
- U19 – birth year (2006 & 2007) or after
- U17 – birth year (2008 & 2009) or after– U17 may be combined with U19 for this tournament.
- U15 – birth year (2010 & 2011) or after
- U13- birth year (2012 & 2013) or after



Events offered: Singles & Doubles (if two different genders play together as a team, they will be placed in the open gender doubles draw)

SHUTTLES: Players must provide their own shuttles. Yonex As20 **Feather Shuttles** must be used for the Open, U19 and U17 age players (Tubes of Yonex AS20 Feather shuttles will be available for sale \$35 per tube at the draw desk). Plastic shuttles will be provided for all the under 15 & 13 age brackets.

EYEWEAR: The use of safety eyewear is strongly recommended.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Various draw formats will be used to guarantee every player gets a minimum of three matches per event. (Pool Play, Compass draws, ABCD) All Singles Games will be best of 3 to 15 points (win by 2 points but ending at 21). Open doubles will be best of 3 to 21 points (win by 2 points ending at 30) All Junior doubles is best of 3 to 15points (win by 2 points but ending at 21).
