



Saint John Regional Flying Feather Series

- DATES:** Saturday, February 26, 830 am to 530 pm (see schedule for tentative times)
- PRIZES:** U19, U17, U15, U13: Medals awarded to first and second place of A section. Prizes awarded to winner of B and C sections. No prize for winner of D section. If round robin draw, medals awarded to first and second place.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$25 for one event / \$35 for two events - payable at draw desk upon arrival
- CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:** The tournament is open to all players who have active memberships with Badminton New Brunswick for the current 2021/22 season.
- All participants (except children 12 and under) must be able to show proof of two COVID-19 vaccinations and a valid ID before entering gym.
- AGE CATEGORIES:** U19 – players born in 2004, 2005 or later
U17 – players born in 2006, 2007 or later
U15 – players born in 2008, 2009 or later
U13 – players born in 2010, 2011 or later
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Thursday, February 24th, 9 pm
- HOW TO REGISTER:** Email Diane MacLeod at macdi@nb.sympatico.ca with the following details
1. Full name
 2. Birth year
 3. Gender, male or female
 4. Events being played – singles, doubles, or both
 5. If playing doubles, indicate partner's name or requesting a partner
 6. Age category for singles and doubles
- REGISTRATION LIMIT:** Saint John Regional one day tournaments are limited to 50 players' total (as per Covid regulations)
Acceptance is on a first registered basis. Players may only sign up for one single and/or one double category.
- ORGANIZERS:** Saint John Junior Badminton Club and Kennebecasis Valley Badminton Club.
- VENUE:** Simonds High School, 1490 Hickey Road, Saint John NB, E2J 4E7



PLEASE NOTE:

*** At regional tournaments we allow females to be placed in draws with males if requested and as well if there are not enough female participants to make a female only draw. If a particular age category does not have enough players then they will be merged with the age category above them. Our focus is game experience and fun rather than separating genders and ages that do not have enough players to make at least a round robin draw of four***

FORMAT:

A, B, C, D draws. If not enough for this type of draw, then round robin will be played. We will do our best to guarantee three matches in each event. Depending on number of participants, games for U15 and U13 may be modified to 15 points in a best of 3-game match.

SHUTTLES:

Yonex Mavis 300 plastic shuttles. Feather shuttles can be used if supplied by player or player's club. If both players cannot agree on which shuttle to use, then a plastic shuttle will be used. Feather shuttles will be available for sale from the draw desk for a cost of \$30 per tube (Li Ning A+90).

EYEWEAR:

The use of safety eyewear is recommended.

SCHEDULE:

Doors open at 800 am.

830 am to 100 pm - U15 singles, followed by doubles

1000 am to 100pm - U13 singles, followed by doubles

100 pm to 530 pm - U17 singles and U19 singles, followed by doubles

These times are subject to change depending on number of registrations.

SPECTATORS:

Spectators/parents will be permitted inside the school gym. All spectators/parents will respect the mandatory order for masking and physical distancing. Proof of two COVID-19 vaccinations and a valid ID must be presented before entering gym.
